

Okizu Privacy Policy

Okizu is pleased to provide information about our online privacy policy. Please be assured that we use our best efforts to protect the privacy of visitors to our website.

Types of Information Collected and How It Is Used

Okizu gathers and retains certain personal information, such as first and last names, home addresses, email addresses, phone numbers, and credit card numbers, that you voluntarily submit. If you make a donation, we collect this information in order to process that donation. This applies to both online and offline donations.

With your permission, we will use this personal information to email you news about Okizu, including information about fundraising campaigns or major grant initiatives. You may opt out of these emails at any time.

Access

You are in control of all personal information you provide to us. If at any time you would like to correct the personal information we have about you or to change your preferences, just contact us. If you would like to unsubscribe from our email list, please use the unsubscribe link at the bottom of our newsletter emails or contact us at the Okizu office. It may take up to two weeks to remove you from our email newsletter list.

Sharing of Personal Information

Okizu may engage companies to perform a variety of necessary functions, such as collecting donations and providing technical services. These companies may have access to personal information if needed to perform these functions, but they may use this information only to perform those functions and not for any other purpose.

Other than as provided in this privacy policy, Okizu does not sell, transfer, share, or disclose personal information to third parties.

Okizu reserves the right to use or disclose any information necessary to satisfy any law, regulation, or legal request, to protect the integrity of our website, to fulfill your requests, or to cooperate in a law enforcement investigation or an investigation on a public safety matter.

Cookies
