Application Info

- All our Camper Applications will be going LIVE on February 16th at noon PST. These include the in-person and virtual camper applications.
- ► Family Camp Applications will be LIVE on February 28th at noon PST.
- Due to size variations with each rental site our camper capacity is smaller than in previous years.
- We ask you to be in communication if you need to change your camper's session OR if they will not be able to attend camp.
- We encourage everyone to register as soon as they know their summer plans.





Transportation

- We will not be providing transportation for campers or volunteer staff this summer.
- We encourage you to do research about what session/camp site is best for you and your capacity to travel.
- We may be able to offer some assistance with transportation needs and you will be able to make this request on your camper application.

Medical Coverage

- Our Oncology Camp sessions will be staffed by two pediatric oncologist and 2-3 pediatric oncology nurses.
- Our SIBS Camp sessions will be staffed by 2 registered nurses.
- Our medical team will be proportional to our camper's and staff's needs.



Covid Vaccine Requirements

We are working with our medical advisory committee to create clear safety guidelines to bring us together in person once again. At this time, full vaccination for covid-19 is required to attend in person programs. We will continue to offer virtual programs for those who are unable to join us in person.

Mask Requirement

Since campers and their staff will be sleeping in the same indoor area, each cabin group will be considered a **cohort**.

Masks of surgical grade or higher (KN95 or N95) are required. New surgical masks will be provided by Okizu at the end of each meal.

Masks are to be worn whenever you are interacting with others outside your cohort.

Kiddos will need to be masked when indoors no matter the distance between you.

You will not be asked to wear a mask while eating, drinking, or swimming.





How will camp be different in 2022


- Families will be responsible for transportation to and from camp. No buses.

How will camp be the same in 2022


- There will be laughs, friendship, singing, and s'mores.


