The auctioneer will state the opening bid for each item and make requests for raised bids. Your bidding number is on your paddle. To place a bid, please make your bidding number visible to the auctioneer by raising your paddle.

Auction spotters will observe the bidding and present the winning bidder with a bid sheet for signature.

### COCKTAIL AUCTION

All silent auction items, including art, will have bid sheets. The bidder must clearly print full name and bidder number and amount of bid on bid sheet. To constitute a valid bid, minimum bids and increments must be honored. Once a bid is entered, it may not be removed.

We will announce a 15 minute warning signaling final bids to be made.

The winning bidders will be posted in the Dining Room and by the Cashier Station. The cashier will be open for check-out beginning at 10:00 pm. Please allow the cashiers time to process your paperwork by waiting until the scheduled check-out time. Winning bidders are responsible for payment and pick-up of merchandise after the evening's entertainment. After you settle your account, we will be happy to hold any of your items at the pick-up station until you are ready to go home.

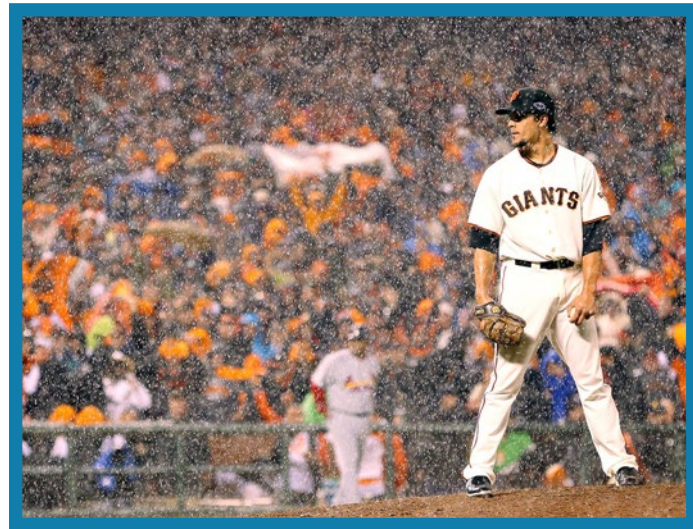

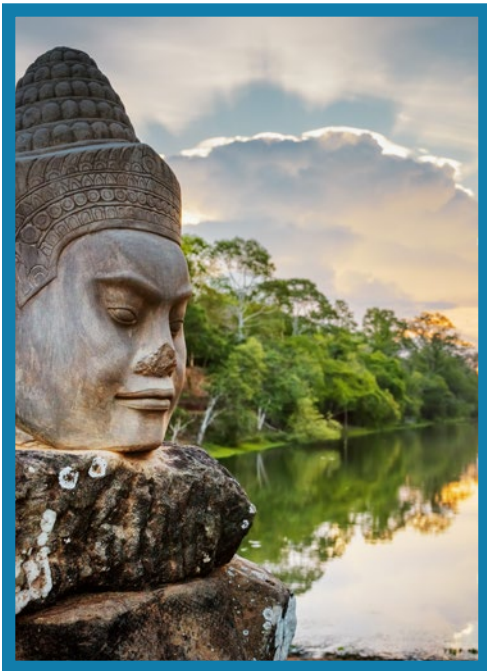
## 106 BLUE AND ORANGE GODIVA BAG BY RAY KLEINLEIN

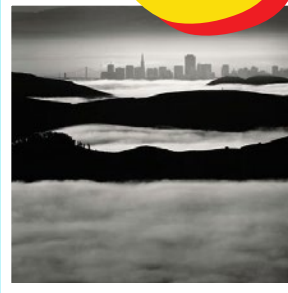

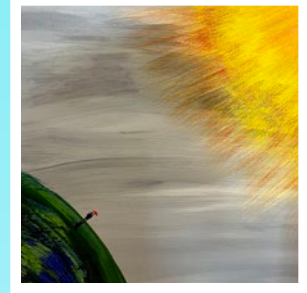

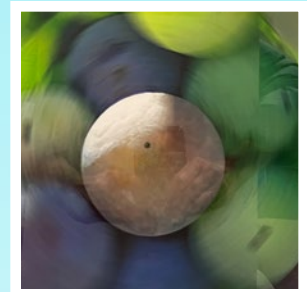

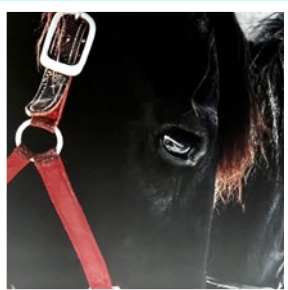

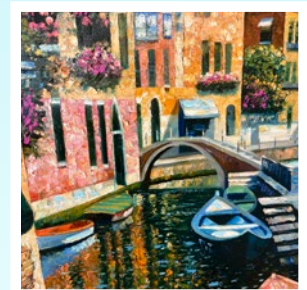

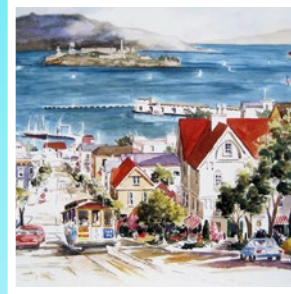

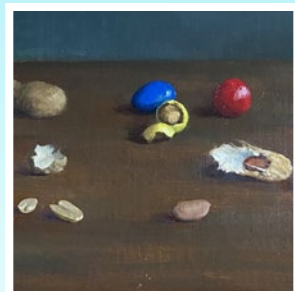
